Description:

The Environmental Commissioner is a non-partisan officer of the Village of Port Washington North, appointed by the Board of Trustees. The Commissioner is tasked with monitoring and reporting on the Village's compliance with NYS Department of Environmental Conservation regulations. The Commissioner at the Board's request will provide guidance with respect to compliance with the requirements of the DEC, assist in providing educational programs pertaining to the environment, and review the handling and disposition of investigations by the Village's Building and Public Works Departments.

The Environmental Commissioner advises Village Boards and Departments on how their policies and actions may enhance Port Washington North's quality of life by creating a healthier, more sustainable environment. In supporting his/her mission, the Commissioner actively participates in monthly Board of Trustees meetings, the Village's planning process; researches and reports on environmental topics; develops educational outreach activities and material (in connection with the Manhasset Bay Protection Committee); responds to inquiries from residents; and coordinates with other municipal boards, commissions and departments and community organizations on issues of mutual interest.

The Environmental Commissioner prepares the Annual Report of the Village in connections with the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System ("MS-4"), as required by and to be filed with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation. An engineering background is preferred.
