

A proposed local law to amend Chapter 73 Buildings unsafe to require the installation and maintenance of carbon monoxide alarms/detectors in places of public assembly.

BILL 2 of 2014

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Port Washington North will hold a public hearing commencing at 7:30 p.m., on Tuesday, May 6, 2014, at the Village Hall, 71 Old Shore Road, Port Washington, New York 11050, to consider the adoption of Bill 1 of 2014, amending Chapter 156, Section 156.4 application for a permit to remove or alter trees on private property. The proposed bill would amend the Village of Port Washington Village Code and establish additional requirements to obtain a permit to remove or alter trees on private property. The additional requirements that would be submitted with the application would include submission of photographs showing the tree(s) to be removed or altered and photographs showing the persons neighboring property from the tree(s) to be removed. Additional requirements are also being proposed to the application to remove or alter a tree on personal property. This notice is given pursuant to Section 4-412, subdivision 3(9), of the Village Law of the State of New York.

At said public hearing all parties in interest will be given an opportunity to be heard. Copies of the proposed local law are on file with the Village Hall and may be seen during normal business hours.
