BILL 4 of 2014

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Port Washington North will hold a public hearing commencing at 7:30 p.m., on Wednesday, January 7, 2015, at the Village Hall, 3 Pleasant Avenue, Port Washington, New York 11050, to consider the adoption of Bill 4 of 2014, amending Chapter 162 Section 162.3 Parking of commercial vehicles. The proposed bill would prohibit parking of commercial vehicles on the streets, roadways or public highways within the Incorporated Village of Port Washington North. However, this section shall not apply to nor prohibit the stopping, standing or parking of authorized emergency vehicles, public utilities or contractors' vehicles while engaged in the repair, maintenance, inspection or construction of streets or utilities within the Village of Port Washington North and contractors or work people's vehicles while those contractors or workpeople are engaged in providing bona fide services to residents or merchants within the Village of Port Washington North. This notice is given pursuant to Section 4-412, subdivision 3(9), of the Village Law of the State of New York.

At said public hearing all parties in interest will be given an opportunity to be heard. Copies of the proposed local law are on file with the Village Hall and may be seen during normal business hours. Any one needing special accommodation pursuant to the American with Disabilities Act should contact the Village Clerk at least four (4) business days before the meeting.
