## ***BAY WALK PARK GRAND OPENING!***

For the last few months you may have noticed the construction going on along the water across the street from Stop and Shop. That will soon end. We are pleased to announce the grand opening of the Bay Walk Park Phase 2 on Saturday June 24.

The new park will include a kayak launch and boat resting area, new artwork expanding the Outdoor Nautical Art Museum; a parking lot and drop off zone, family picnic area with sun shades, an electronic informational kiosk, a water bottle replenishing station complete with a water fountain and a pet water station, a rain garden, and the expansion of our Port North pier float. The project is the final phase of the Bay Walk Park Master Plan created in 2003 and was designed by Cameron Engineering & Associates LLP and constructed by Woodstock Construction of Oyster Bay. The project, which cost \$1,500,000 was supported by the entire Port Washington community as well as nearly every level of government, including generous funding by New York State Department of State; New York State Office of Parks, Recreation, and Historical Preservation; the Town of North Hempstead; and Nassau County.

It is our hope that the additions to our beautiful waterfront will attract visitors from across Long Island and, in turn, encourage the growth of our local businesses. We thank you for your patience while construction was underway and invite all residents to attend the opening ceremony and ribbon cutting that will take place from 11:00 am to 12:30 pm
